Welcome

Welcome to our new cohort of DTP students of the 2021 cohort. We have 25 new starters joining our existing cohorts in Leeds, York and Hull. We will have 11 students joining our Climate and Atmosphere, 7 our Living World and 7 our Earth Processes theme. For this cohort 3 students will be located at the Wolfson Atmospheric Chemistry Labs in York, 2 in the Energy and Environment Institute in Hull and 20 at the University of Leeds. If you meet one of our new starters please welcome them. We also hope that the more relaxed conditions at the universities allow us to hold cross-cohort events in the future.

Research Experience Placements

Over the summer DTP researchers hosted 5 undergraduate students for Research Experience Placements (REPs). For up to 6 weeks these early career researchers worked on projects studying the ongoing chemical evolution of Earth due to micro-meteorites, remote sensing for soil-health monitoring, and the contribution of Nitrogen Dioxide for UK air quality, measuring atmospheric ice-nucleating particles, and quantifying atmospheric turbulent length scales in model and flight data. We hope these placements gave them a good insight into research and motivated them to continue with research.

Cohort Activities

Induction Residential

The 2021 cohort had their induction residential at the Field Centre of the Field Studies Council at Malham Tarn. During this week they did some science, received some training, and took part in some outdoor activities. Most importantly there was plenty of time to talk and get to know each other.

COVID-19 Impact Extensions

UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) has provided limited funding for funded extensions for stipends and fees. Students within 6 months of their funding end date will be eligible to apply for this additional funding. UKRI expect that projects have been adapted to account for the disruptions in the last 1.5 years and that funding for most extensions, except in exceptional circumstances, to be less than 3 months. We have prepared an [online form](#) if you want to apply for this funding and you are eligible. Funding will be provided on a needs basis and a panel consisting of representatives from the 3 DTP universities and a student representative will assess the proposals. We aim to fund as many extensions as financially possible.
